

WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN OF ARGENTEUIL 2016-2020

DID YOU KNOW?

- Waste management on the territory of Argenteuil costs close to 2.8 million dollars a year and that landfill contributes to 59% of the costs;
- The majority of the Argenteuil municipalities landfills more than the average outside its territory;
- Close to 60% of waste generated is sent to landfills and that approximately 34% is organic
 waste that could be otherwise reused;
- Important players, such as Tricentris, invest in creating solutions for the reuse of waste;
- The Argenteuil MRC has on its territory all the necessary infrastructure for waste treatment, which is a force in the perspective of sustainable management;
- In 2020, the government of Quebec asks that all MRCs recycle 100% of its organic waste and that at this time only 3 municipalities out of 9 in Argenteuil offer collection services.
